Letter from Fire Chief Tomblin regarding Washington Tornado Response

Please see the attached letter from Fire Chief Kent Tomblin which commends the members of the Peoria Fire Department who aided in the Washington tornado response.

Building Permit Assistance in Washington

One Peoria Building Inspector from the Community Development Department has been assigned to assist the City of Washington on a full time basis until the end of the year. This assistance consists of reviewing building plans and making site visits to building locations in Washington. Several of the City's Building Inspectors will be rotated as part of this assistance to ensure that the City continues to pay attention to the plan review and inspection responsibilities in Peoria.

River Edge Redevelopment Zone Approved

The Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity approved the City of Peoria's proposed River Edge Redevelopment Zone (RERZ), effective for 30 years, beginning December 1, 2013. Peoria is one of five communities in Illinois designated as pilot communities. The others are East St. Louis, Rockford, Aurora and Elgin.

The RERZ is another valuable catalyst for private development to create a vibrant, mixed use neighborhood in the City's Warehouse District area. The RERZ is designed to encourage reuse of environmentally-challenged properties to allow for safe and economically productive use.

Note that the State concurrently approved deletion of properties located in the Enterprise Zone to accommodate the newly established RERZ, as the boundaries may not overlap. These are the same boundaries previously approved by City Council (see attached map).

A few steps remain before property owners may fully benefit from the zone, most significantly:

1. Establish a Historic National Register District (RFP). This will enable the use of the Illinois Historic Tax Credit.

2. Submit a plan for encouraging participation by minority persons, females, persons with disabilities, and veterans (to the Illinois Department of Commerce).

RERZ benefits include:

1. Income tax deduction
2. Investment Tax Credits: Allow business in RERZ to claim additional .5% credit on IL Corporate Income Tax for qualified depreciable property. The Illinois Tax Act allows an additional credit equal to 0.5% of the basis of qualified property placed in service during the taxable year in a River Edge Redevelopment Zone, provided the taxpayer's base employment within Illinois has increased by 1% or more over the preceding year as determined by the taxpayer's employment records filed with the Illinois Department of Employment Security.
3. Environmental Remediate Tax Credit: State Income Tax credit of 25% on some non-reimbursed eligible costs for remediation work, approved by the IEPA in excess of \$100,000; and credit is limited to \$40,000 per year; and \$150,000 per project.
4. Dividend Income Deduction: Available to Individuals, corporations, trusts and estates; and income tax deduction equal to the amount of dividends received from businesses with substantially all of their operations in the RERZ.
5. Interest Income Deduction: available to financial corporations, may deduct amount equal to interest received for a loan for development in an RERZ from their corporate State Income Tax.
6. Building Materials Sales Tax Exemption: sales tax exemption on construction materials for non-residential projects within the RERZ.
7. Property Tax Abatement - Not currently proposed within Peoria; cannot apply in TIF.
8. Illinois Historic Preservation Tax Credit: amount equal to 25% qualified expenditures for the restoration and preservation of a qualified historic structure per a qualified plan in a RERZ may be deducted from taxes; and minimum project cost is \$5000 and must exceed 50% of purchase price of the property. Eligibility is determined by DCEO and the IL Historic Preservation Agency.


So to everyone, thank you. You have made all of us proud to be Firefighters.


