**SUBJECT:** Issues Update

The following are issues related to the City for the weekly Issues Update. If there are additional items you believe should be included, please let me know.

### **City to Allocate 2013 Volume Cap to Assist Program**

Each year the City of Peoria receives an allocation of Private Activity Bonds, known as the Volume Cap, from the State of Illinois for eligible economic development and housing projects. The amount of allocation is calculated by multiplying \$95 by the population of the City of Peoria as listed in the *State of Illinois Guidelines and Procedures for the Allocation of Private Activity Bonding Authority*.

On February 26, 2013, Peoria City Council passed Ordinance # 16,933 reserving its 2013 Volume Cap of \$10,947,230. Private Activity Bonds are exempt from federal income tax once they are in the hand of the holders, thus lowering the cost of capital to the borrower. Another benefit of the Bonds is long term financing, generally more than 20 years. Projects that may be eligible to use Private Activity Bonds are: industrial, manufacturing, and low or moderate income housing projects. In March and October, 2013, staff placed notices in the *Issues Update* as well as in the Peoria Journal Star to advise the community that this bonding capacity was available and asked that anyone interested in utilizing the Volume Cap contact the Economic Development Office. Staff has not received interest from private developers as of this date. Without industrial or manufacturing project interest and to ensure that the Cap is not lost to the City of Peoria, staff will allocate the 2013 Volume Cap to the Assist First Time Homebuyers Program (***Guidelines Attached as Electronic Copy Only***). ### **November, 2013 Zoning Board of Appeals - Summary of Outcomes**

**2800 NE Perry:** Existing rock storage in the I-2 Zoning District. Voted 7-0 to grant a variance to allow an existing business in the I-2 Zoning District to store (existing rock) in the front yard behind an existing solid fence (supported by staff).

*3020 W. Lincoln:* Vacant gas station requesting variances to allow a convenience store addition (this is next to CVS, near Kroger).

- Voted 7-0 to grant six variances to permit existing conditions (supported by staff).
- Voted 7-0 to grant two additional variances to allow the building and the canopy to have different materials; and, to waive the requirement for the canopy to be structurally and architecturally integrated with the main building (these were not supported by staff).
- Voted 7-0 to DENY two variances related to building/canopy height ratio and signage; therefore, the canopy may not exceed the height of the building and the nonconforming signage will be removed (supported by staff).

# Assist 2013 Homebuyer Assistance

---

Affordable home ownership for families

## Program Outline

An innovative program sponsored by communities throughout the state that offers families the opportunity to buy their own home. The home buyer assistance feature of the *Assist* program provides families with funds to pay all or most of their closing costs and down payment, enabling families with good credit but little available capital to buy their first home.



### Overview

- Communities join together and issue tax-exempt single family bonds
- Home rule communities contribute private activity bond volume cap
- Non-home rule communities apply for volume cap from the State
- No financial contribution or commitment required from any participant
- Any Illinois municipality can participate

### Description of Bond Issue

- Tax-exempt bonds are issued using the combined volume cap of the communities or taxable securities are sold when market conditions warrant
- The bonds and securities are sold at a premium, a price greater than their face amount
- Proceeds of the bonds and securities are used to make the home loans and fund the assistance
- The premium supplies the extra funds to provide home buyer assistance
- The bonds and securities are not a debt of the municipalities or paid from any participating communities funds
- The City of Aurora acts as issuer on behalf of all the communities
- The bonds and securities are secured by loans on homes purchased with **Assist**

### Loan Description


- 30 year fixed rate loans
- FHA/VA loans available
- **Assist** pays 3% cash assistance to qualifying home buyers to fund closing costs and down payment assistance
- Loans are funded with proceeds of the bonds
- Loan interest rate determined at bond closing
- Loan interest rate below conventional loan rates as of bond closing

## Qualifying Homebuyers

- First time home buyers (not owned residence in three years)
- Will occupy the home as their residence
- Meet income guidelines
- Meet purchase price guidelines

## Advantages

- Provides additional home ownership opportunities in each Community
- Home ownership provides added stability in a community
- Serves the 40% of potential home buyers who qualify for loans but lack funds
- Strategic alliance with lenders throughout the state
- Customized marketing in each municipality
- No out-of-pocket expense to any community to participate
