SUBJECT: Issues Update

The following are issues related to the City for the weekly Issues Update. If there are additional items you believe should be included, please let me know.

Granicus Implementation

The Granicus Agenda Management Suite will be implemented for the City Clerk's office over the next three months. The City is currently using Granicus to push agendas out to iPads for the Council. We have purchased their Legislative Management Suite. This includes applications to create the agenda and packet, manage workflow and seamless interaction with iLegislate. Granicus will also work with the City's current videographers to enhance the video recordings available to the public. Meeting videos will be integrated with the agenda so you will not have to guess to see a specific item online. Granicus offers unlimited storage data, so the City will not have to purchase extra servers. In looking to the future, Granicus offers VoteLog which allows the public to search voting history, electronic voting through iPads and public displays, which will assist the audience in following the meeting.

Fair Housing Advocacy Training

As a recipient of HUD funds, the City has a responsibility to take steps to affirmatively further fair housing within our community. The Equal Opportunity Office, with assistance from the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission, has planned an event that helps the City meet this obligation.

On Tuesday, June 18, 2013, the Illinois Department of Human Rights will conduct Fair Housing Advocacy Training. This free training will be held in the Twin Towers Building, 456 Fulton St, Room 420 from 1:00p.m. – 4:30 p.m.

Attendees will learn more about the following:

- Local, state and federal fair housing law
- How to recognize discrimination in housing
- What steps to take to assist an individual who has experienced discrimination in housing
