Peoria Named a Top Ten City for Logistics Infrastructure by Global Trade Magazine

The latest issue of *Global Trade* magazine features the best cities for global trade in a number of categories. In the “Logistics Infrastructure” category, Peoria was ranked in the top ten alongside much larger cities like Los Angeles, New Orleans and St. Louis. The magazine says of Peoria:

“Other Illinois locales may receive more attention, but Peoria shouldn’t be discounted. The city boasts strong cargo connectivity, thanks to a variety of transportation modes. In addition to being situated on a major interstate, Peoria is served by an extensive rail system and the emerging cargo hub General Wayne A. Downing Peoria International Airport. Barge access via the Illinois River further propels Peoria’s freight operations.”

Peoria Fire Recruitment Committee

The Peoria Fire Department labor/management recruitment committee has been actively pursuing potential firefighter candidates. One of the objectives of the committee is to increase the number of protected class individuals participating in the examination process. The examination process consists of a written component and the candidate physical ability test (CPAT). The CPAT is a new addition to the testing process and is endorsed by the International Association of Fire Chiefs (IAFC) and the International Association of Fire Fighters (IAFF).

Committee members have visited various venues consisting of churches, community events, colleges/universities, and others to share the message of a fire service career. In addition to making an effort to connect with the eligible targeted group of 21-35 year olds, the committee is also reviewing strategies to reach out to high school students to instill the possibility of pursuing a profession in fire service by directing youth to educational opportunities in emergency medical services or fire service technology.

The firefighter examination will commence in early 2015, with the exact dates and times to be announced by the Human Resources Department. Questions relating to the recruitment

CITY TO ALLOCATE 2014 VOLUME CAP TO ASSIST PROGRAM

Each year the City of Peoria receives an allocation of Private Activity Bonds, known as the Volume Cap, from the State of Illinois for eligible economic development and housing projects. The amount of allocation is calculated by multiplying \$95 by the population of the City of Peoria as listed in the *State of Illinois Guidelines and Procedures for the Allocation of Private Activity Bonding Authority*.

On February 25, 2014, Peoria City Council passed Ordinance # 17,067 reserving its 2014 Volume Cap of \$11,568,700 (guidelines attached). Private Activity Bonds are exempt from federal income tax once they are in the hand of the holders, thus lowering the cost of capital to the borrower. Another benefit of the Bonds is long term financing, generally more than 20 years. Projects that may be eligible to use Private Activity Bonds are: industrial, manufacturing, and low or moderate income housing projects. In March and September, 2014, staff placed notices in the Peoria Journal Star to advise the community that this bonding capacity was available, and asked that anyone interested in utilizing the Volume Cap contact the Economic Development Office. Staff has not received interest from private developers as of this date. Without industrial or manufacturing project interest, and to ensure that the Cap is not lost to the City of Peoria, staff will allocate the 2014 Volume Cap to the Assist First Time Homebuyers Program. Assist 2014 Homebuyer Assistance

Affordable home ownership for families

Program Outline

An innovative program sponsored by communities throughout the state that offers families the opportunity to buy their own home. The home buyer assistance feature of the *Assist* program provides families with funds to pay all or most of their closing costs and down payment, enabling families with good credit but little available capital to buy their first home.



Overview

- Communities join together and issue tax-exempt single family bonds
- Home rule communities contribute private activity bond volume cap
- Non-home rule communities apply for volume cap from the State
- No financial contribution or commitment required from any participant
- Any Illinois municipality can participate

Description of Bond Issue

- Tax-exempt bonds are issued using the combined volume cap of the communities or taxable securities are sold when market conditions warrant
- The bonds and securities are sold at a premium, a price greater than their face amount
- Proceeds of the bonds and securities are used to make the home loans and fund the assistance
- The premium supplies the extra funds to provide home buyer assistance
- The bonds and securities are not a debt of the municipalities or paid from any participating communities funds
- The City of Aurora acts as issuer on behalf of all the communities
- The bonds and securities are secured by loans on homes purchased with **Assist**

Loan Description


- 30 year fixed rate loans
- FHA/VA loans available
- **Assist** pays 3% cash assistance to qualifying home buyers to fund closing costs and down payment assistance
- Loans are funded with proceeds of the bonds
- Loan interest rate determined at bond closing
- Loan interest rate below conventional loan rates as of bond closing

Qualifying Homebuyers

- First time home buyers (not owned residence in three years)
- Will occupy the home as their residence
- Meet income guidelines
- Meet purchase price guidelines

Advantages

- Provides additional home ownership opportunities in each Community
- Home ownership provides added stability in a community
- Serves the 40% of potential home buyers who qualify for loans but lack funds
- Strategic alliance with lenders throughout the state
- Customized marketing in each municipality
- No out-of-pocket expense to any community to participate
