**Construction Industry Career Expo**

Building Inspections personnel participated in the 2014 Construction Industry Career Expo during the week of September 22<sup>nd</sup>. Eighth grade students who attended the Expo were introduced to the construction industry and the different trades involved in construction projects.

During the event, Inspections personnel discussed the importance of building codes and day-to-day operations with more than 1,100 students. One of the main goals was to explain what a vital role inspections play in the safety of structures. The feedback received was very positive from all parties involved.

The ultimate goal for the Resident Officer is to empower and equip the neighborhood residents toward self sufficiency this will occur by:


- Working closely with residents to develop a mutual trust
