SUBJECT: Issues Update

The following are issues related to the City for the weekly Issues Update. If there are additional items you believe should be included, please let me know.

Police Department Staffing Update

The Neighborhood Services Unit made several changes in the month of June. Sherry Carter-Allen officially transferred from her former position with Code Enforcement to the Police Department. Sherry has joined the Neighborhood Services Unit as the in-house Code Enforcement Officer.

Two additional Officers are also joining the unit as of the end of June. Officer Chris White will begin working in the area of the new Resident Officer Home at 1916 W. Kettelle, which the City took possession of on Wednesday, June 25th. The home will undergo some interior cosmetic renovations which will begin immediately. Officer White will be moving into the residence by the end of August. Officer White will begin addressing issues in the area on June 29th while he awaits the completion of renovations.

Officer Doug Burgess started his new assignment on Sunday, June 29th, as the City's newest Nuisance Abatement Officer. Officer Burgess will work evenings and weekends to provide more coverage in addressing nuisance properties.

The growing Neighborhood Services Unit is now occupying two offices on the lower floor of the Police Department. The unit has already been extremely busy addressing problem properties. The team is planning a number of neighborhood details in the near future, meeting and greeting neighbors, taking action on violations, and promoting an improved quality of life in the City's neighborhoods.

Recyclable Metal Dealer Ordinance

The Police Department is working on a new Recyclable Metals Dealer Ordinance in response to the numerous copper and air conditioner thefts that have been occurring. The ordinance is similar to the Second Hand Dealer Ordinance that was recently passed and will assist the Department in monitoring who is scrapping and selling copper alloys and air conditioner parts, with the intention of identifying suspects responsible for thefts. The plan is to have a draft of the ordinance completed in the next couple weeks and have the final version ready for a first reading by the 2nd City Council meeting in July.

TOWNLINER ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

The Townline Road Project (340 feet east of Industrial Road to University Street) is about to get underway. We view this project as a partnership, with the Contractor, **Illinois Civil Contractors, Inc.**, the City of Peoria, and the businesses, as stakeholders in the project.

The City of Peoria and the Contractor are pledged to provide the best possible project.

Construction Schedule (Begins July 7th)

Electronic notification boards have been placed this week to notify motorists of the upcoming July 7th Construction start date.

Townline Road, from 340 feet of Industrial Road to University Street, will be reconstructed with new concrete pavement, curb and gutter, storm drain inlets and pipework, a new 9 foot wide asphalt bike trail on the north side of the roadway, and a new 5 foot wide sidewalk on the south. All existing driveway approaches will be removed and replaced with Portland Concrete Cement

pavement along the roadway. Existing entrance walks and driveways behind the sidewalks shall be removed, and replaced for adjustment purposes, only as necessary. All disturbed areas will be restored with sod. Existing retaining walls within the Right-of-Way will also be removed and replaced.

Weather permitting, **the construction** on the improvement is scheduled to **begin Monday, July 7th** with traffic control installation early that week.

There will be two construction stages to the project. The first stage will allow only a single through lane for westbound traffic as the median and eastbound lane are removed. The second phase will shift to a westbound lane closure and the eastbound lane open. These traffic configurations will be in place approximately a month on each this side. **Temporary access to driveways along Townline Road will be provided during construction, but each driveway will be closed for up to 3 days at the point of reconstruction.**

Construction Schedule, continued...



Children are welcome to view the work and equipment, but only under direct parental supervision. A work site is dangerous to the uninitiated or unwary!

The contractor will, at times, take the parking lane of the street for staging of materials and equipment. Also, **construction workers will be present.**

Motorists are urged to use caution in the construction area at all times.



Installation of sidewalk and bike trail will occur in conjunction with the north half and south half work, respectively.

Roadway demolition, aggregate base preparation, and concrete roadway pavement work will occur in July and tentatively end by October.

Lastly, the landscaping contractor will perform **topsoil and sod work** after the sidewalks, curb, retaining walls, and new pavement are placed.

Contractor

We will endeavor to **complete this project** by the end of October, 2014. As always, that is dependent upon the weather.

Detour signs will be installed in the area. Please be aware of the appropriate route markers if you must travel through the area.

ICCI will strive to include all stakeholders in the partnering process to complete this project.

Motorists should be aware of the barricades and work activities, which will be ever-changing due to the nature of a construction project.

??? Common Questions ???

⇒ Sidewalk Concrete Cracking

All Portland cement concrete will crack. By its very nature, concrete does not do well under the tension created as the material cures and gains strength. This tension is the reason the grooves are placed. By providing these grooves, we introduce a point of weakness to cause the crack to be in the bottom of the groove. Also in an effort to control the cracking, expansion joints are placed at about 40-foot intervals. Further, small fibers are placed

within the concrete. All these efforts--control, expansion joints, and fiber--are attempts to control cracking. In addition to these measures, all materials used are inspected to ensure their compliance to job specifications. All project personnel are concerned about the quality of the finished product.

⇒ Contractor Doing Private Work

One question often raised is: "Can the contractor do work on my private

property?" The City has no objection to our contractor doing work for adjacent property owners while constructing the Townline Road project. The On-Site Engineer will coordinate that work with the City's contractor. The cost of private work must be paid directly to the contractor by the Property Owner.

If you wish to use a different contractor for private work, you may. Again, the On-Site Engineer will coordinate the work.

A winter "helpful hint"

To keep your new sidewalk in good shape: Refrain from using de-icing chemicals such as salt or calcium chloride on new concrete. Instead, use sand or kitty litter, for traction.




