Economic Development—GateWay Ground Breaking



A groundbreaking ceremony was held at 1 p.m. on Wednesday, Sept. 2, for ***GateWay at River City***, a 106-apartment affordable assisted living community for adults with physical disabilities. The \$21 million development will be located at the corner of W. Romeo B. Garrett Ave and N. Richard Pryor Place.

Peoria Police Department -New Squad Car by Lieutenant Kenneth Snow

On July 30th, the city took delivery of four Ford Interceptor Utility vehicles. This year the Police Department has been evaluating vehicles to replace the Chevy Impala squad car the department has used since the turn of the century. For the past 15 years the Chevy Impala has been the workhorse of the city's police fleet but starting in 2016 Chevy will cease production of that model of police package thus requiring the city's largest department to decide upon a replacement mode of transportation. Fleet Manager Bob Williams, Police Lieutenant Ken Snow and a test committee of 13 patrol officers have been field testing a few of the options available. Officers thus far have evaluated the Chevy Tahoe and Dodge Charger. These Fords can be powered by both E-85 and regular unleaded fuel. They will be deployed in the Traffic & Patrol Divisions. There are several aspects being examined in order to reach a conclusion, some of which include vehicle safety, cost, gas mileage, maintenance cost/reliability, visibility, handling and the all-wheel drive capabilities and 3 inches of additional ground clearance over the sedan will be a great asset in the winter months. One major feature being examined is the availability of room. Over the years the amount of equipment a squad car must be equipped with has increased dramatically. Nowadays a standard patrol car is outfitted with a myriad of hardware including laptop computers, printers, on board cameras, center consoles, and back seat partitions- all of which limits the space for the most important asset in the vehicle, the actual police officer. The most common

complaint among officers using the Chevy Impala was the lack of space for themselves, personal equipment and any additional passengers. Bob Williams and Lt Snow have also been overseeing the field testing a fuel saving device now on the market that has the potential to decrease the amount of fuel used during an officer's shift by limiting engine run time during idling. All these efforts combined should help in reaching a conclusion that will benefit both the officer on patrol and the citizens they serve.

PSD 150-Update

From Peoria Public Schools Interim Superintendent Dr. Sharon Desmoulin-Kherat: It's a REMARKABLE Day...

It's a remarkable day at Peoria Public Schools. That's the answer you should receive when you call any of our schools or buildings, and it has indeed been our theme since school began three weeks ago now. I want to share a few highlights and recognitions that are taking place in our District.

- Last week, we held our first monthly Parent University meeting of the year. Sterling Middle School hosted the event. Parents were able to choose two of 14 workshops to attend in addition to a dinner and a keynote speaker. There were 150 parents that signed in at the event, with just as many students who also participated in activities throughout the night. Our next event is coming up soon (September 17th) and we are moving the location from Whittier Primary to Calvin Coolidge Middle School so that we have enough space for this growing event!
- Peoria Police Officer Morris Franklin works at Peoria High School as one of our School Resource Officers through an agreement with the City. Because of Officer Franklin's leadership, last Monday, the Manual Academy and Peoria High School communities, along with our larger Peoria area community, kicked off the Week of Peace, an effort supported by the Peoria Police Department, our District and Peoria Community Against Violence (P-CAV). Officer Franklin pitched the idea of a week of peace to P-CAV this spring. His idea won funding from P-CAV worked to promote good sportsmanship and camaraderie among both Manual and Peoria High families and fans. It was a great and well-attended event. Proceeds from t-shirt sales are being donated to a scholarship fund to recognize students who show community spirit. Last week, Illinois State Superintendent Tony Smith notified our District that all seven of our submissions for Those Who Excel awards will be recognized at ISBE's annual banquet in October. All of the winners were also recognized by our District at the Staff Convocation held at Bradley on August 13th.

- I received communication from Illinois State Board of Education recognizing Manual teacher Crystal Kennerly for her experience and knowledge in serving on a State committee reviewing
