Warehouse District Ribbon Cutting

The official unveiling of the completed Warehouse District infrastructure projects was held on June 11, 2015 at the roundabout of Harrison & Washington Streets. The completion of this project transformed over 30 blocks of downtown Peoria. This \$25 million dollar project was partially funded by a TIGER II Transportation Grant.

Peoria i-team HEADS TO NYC



On June 8-9, the Peoria Innovation Team (i-team) traveled to New York City for a convening of the 14 Bloomberg Philanthropies Innovation Teams program grant recipients. The event was designed not only to help team members build and hone skills they will soon use to tackle local challenges, but to connect teams to one another as well as to resources at Living Cities, Bennett Midland, and Bloomberg Philanthropies.

Sessions focused on idea generation, citizen engagement, crafting narratives, and exploring innovation through adaptive learning. Past grant recipients as well as bold innovators like Janette Sadik-Khan, the former commissioner of New York City's Department of Transportation, shared their insights to success at innovation in the government domain. The team is excited to bring these new perspectives back to Peoria.

MacArthur Bridge

Recently, the Illinois Department of Transportation's Bureau of Bridges and Structures conducted a structural evaluation of the MacArthur Highway Bridge. The bridge, which carries MacArthur Highway over W. Romeo B. Garrett Avenue, was constructed in 1942, and currently has a posted weight limit of 14 Tons. The reevaluation of the bridge, which took into account the condition and age of the structure, has determined that the bridge requires a new posted weight limit of 10 Tons. This posting will be accomplished by installing "10 ton weight limit" signs at the structure and in advance of it. A replacement for this structure is currently being designed by a city consultant, with construction planned in fiscal year 2017.

**JUNE 17 PUBLIC MEETING OF ONEWATER COMMITTEE:
DISCUSSING PROGRAM PRIORITIES**

WHO: The City of Peoria and the advisory group, OneWater Committee

WHAT: A public session discussing/prioritizing elements of the City's wet weather management program

WHEN: June 17, 12–1:30 p.m.

WHERE: Gateway Building, room 201

WHO SHOULD ATTEND: Everyone — open to public.

WHY: The recent storms serve as a powerful reminder of the importance of responsible wet weather management. Stormwater-caused issues can negatively affect public safety, roads, private properties and more.

This meeting will outline various components of wet weather management. Examples include stream restoration, private property drainage assistance, pollution prevention and more. The OneWater Committee and general attendees will rank the importance of each item as low, medium or high priority. Attendees are asked to prepare by completing the provided worksheets, and coming ready to discuss their thoughts.

Peoria currently faces many wet weather issues. These include:

- **Increasing regulatory requirements.** The U.S. EPA has mandated Peoria to reduce the incidence of overflows from combined storm/sanitary sewers.
- **A backlog of stormwater-related projects across the city.** Due to funding challenges, Peoria has not been able to keep up with the maintenance and upgrades needed.
- **The need to inspect and repair aging infrastructure.** The condition of many underground City storm sewer pipes is unknown. By better monitoring the system, Peoria can extend the useful life of existing infrastructure and make minor repairs before they become major emergencies.
