### **Peoria Public Schools – Update from Superintendent Dr. Sharon Desmoulin-Kherat**

The application process for the Richwoods High School International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme opened in mid-September and remains open until Friday, November 18. Students entering 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> or 11<sup>th</sup> grade in 2017-2018 are eligible to apply.

A parent information meeting will be held on Thursday, October 27 at 6 p.m. at Richwoods High School. The interview portion of the application process will take place in December and acceptance/denial letters will be mailed in January.

There are nearly 2,800 IB World Schools on all six inhabited continents (143 countries) offering the Diploma Programme. Of those, 894 are located in the United States and only 36 public and private IB schools are in Illinois, primarily in the Chicago metropolitan area. Richwoods High School offers the only downstate IB Diploma Programme.

The IB Diploma Programme is an academically challenging two year curriculum which begins during a student's junior year of high school. The IB aims to develop self-motivated student inquirers who are globally minded and who exit high school well-prepared for the rigors of the college.

Students who graduate with the IB Diploma are academically ready to excel in post-secondary school. IB graduates frequently enter college with a semester or even a full year worth of transferrable college credit, making it an outstanding educational value.

## **2<sup>nd</sup> Annual East Bluff Sunrise 5K Run**


