### **Community Development –City of Peoria Reveals Two Murals**



The City of Peoria Community Development Center revealed the winners of the city’s first mural contest at a press conference on Monday, August 29 at noon at 3560 SW Adams Street. The murals, created by Bob Drake and Shweta Srivastava will be installed on the city-owned property. Neighborhood Enhancement Coordinator Terence Acquah stated, “The City of Peoria is thrilled to showcase the work of local artists on a building that is a gateway to Peoria.”

### **Community Development Department Introduces New Shuttle Line**

From October 3 through November 11, two bus lines will operate during the business lunch hours (11:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.). The service will be free of charge, and will generally encompass a perimeter from the Kickapoo building (edge of downtown), to baseball stadium, and along the riverfront.

This is a two-phase pilot program. The first six weeks are funded by the Tourism Reserve Fund for \$21,000; marketing is supported in part by the Downtown Development Corporation, the City of Peoria, Civic Center, Peoria Riverfront Association, and Peoria Area Convention and Visitor’s Bureau. If successful, the DDC hopes to raise funds for eight additional weeks. More information will follow, in the coming weeks.

### **Peoria Public Schools – Update from Superintendent Dr. Sharon Desmoulin-Kherat**

Recently the Peoria Public Schools Board of Education joined other school districts in Peoria County to place a ½% sales tax for school facilities on the November 8 ballot. In coming months, citizens will have many opportunities to learn the details of the proposal. For now, here are some important points to know:

- The majority of school buildings in the Peoria Public School district are decades old. For example, Whittier Primary School is 101 years old. Roosevelt Magnet School was built in 1932 and Von Steuben Middle School was built in 1936. Even school buildings many of us consider fairly new,

like Charter Oak and Mark Bills, both built in the late 1970s, are overdue for significant maintenance to improve safety, energy efficiency and to support current technology needs.

- According to Illinois state law, revenue from this sales tax can be used only for maintaining, renovating and upgrading existing school facilities and for new construction.
- The County School Facility Sales Tax represents a shift away from relying on property taxes for local school districts. Not all retail sales will be taxed. Unprepared food (groceries), prescriptions and over-the-counter medications, automobiles and services are among the items that will not be taxed. A ½% tax on a \$7 fast food meal will be three-and-a-half cents. The sales tax would add 35 cents to a \$70 pair of shoes or \$2.25 to a \$450 TV set.
- Investing in school improvements and construction projects will mean a real boost to our local economy. Projects funded by the sales tax will put people to work across Peoria County. Job creation means economic growth for our communities and a better quality of life for everyone in our county. It means a vastly improved learning environment for our children, to support a 21<sup>st</sup> century education and give them the knowledge and tools they need to compete in changing economy.



# Political Sign Reminders

- *Political signs do not require any type of application or permit*
- *In residential districts, political signs cannot exceed 8 square feet in size*
- *In non-residential districts, political signs cannot exceed 32 square feet in size*
- *There is no limit on the number of political signs on a property*
- *Political signs on non-residential property must be removed within 7 days after the election. Political signs on residential property do not have to be removed*
- *No political signs can be placed on the public right-of-way, or on any public property. These signs will be removed by the City*

## PEORIA FIRE RECEIVES GRANT

On Friday August 26, 2016 the Peoria Fire Department was presented with a \$1000 grant from the Enbridge Corporation. Enbridge is an energy delivery company transporting crude oil, liquid hydrocarbons, natural gas, electricity and renewable energy around the world. Sandy Whittle Enbridge Ambassador of the Mid Continent Region made the presentation.

The **Enbridge Safe Community grant** will be used to purchase 2 hydrogen cyanide (HCN) monitors. HCN has evolved into a major area of concern for firefighters. This extremely toxic gas seriously affects the body by causing dizziness, weakness, rapid heartbeat and death.

HCN is 35 times more toxic than carbon monoxide, is produced when wool, silk, cotton, nylon, plastic, polymers, foam, melamine and synthetic rubber burn; will incapacitate a victim within a short time; has a half-life of one hour in the bloodstream; and is highly flammable. Additionally, HCN will remain in the occupancy when burned materials continue to display elevated temperatures.

The monitors will help firefighters assess the atmospheric conditions of the air quality when searching for hidden fires after the bulk of the fire has been extinguished.



Hydrogen Cyanide (HCN) is a dangerous chemical high/low cocktail; created by high temperatures and low oxygen atmospheric conditions. HCN can cause rapid death by metabolic asphyxiation.
