**C-SPAN ANNOUNCES PEORIA'S SELECTION AS A FEATURED CITY OCTOBER 15-16**

### **MAYOR ARDIS, PATHWAYS TO PROSPERITY & PEORIA PUBLIC SCHOOLS LAUNCH INTERNSHIP CHALLENGE**



Mayor Jim Ardis launched the Peoria Mayor's Internship Challenge this week and sent out a call to all area employers to get involved. The Peoria Mayor's Internship Challenge seeks to create a "Culture of Education" by calling on local employers to create internship and job opportunities specifically for Peoria Public Schools high school students, aged 16-18, resulting in at least 50 new internship opportunities for Peoria Public Schools students by June 2017. Organizers of the Mayor's Internship Challenge hope that ongoing and growing employee engagement will result in increasing the number of internships created as the initiative continues.

### **ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH—TIPS FOR HEAT**

SPRINGFIELD - With high temperatures expected over the next couple of days, Illinois Department of Public Health Director Nirav D. Shah, M.D., J.D. is urging Illinoisans to take preventive actions to avoid heat-related illness like heat exhaustion and heat stroke.

“High heat and humidity can lead to serious health problems. It’s important for people to recognize the signs of heat-related illness and take action to prevent becoming sick,” said Director Shah. “To help your body cope with high temperatures, take steps to stay cool, increase your fluid intake, decrease your activities and wear appropriate clothing.”

#### *Stay Cool*

- Stay in air-conditioned buildings. Cooling centers can be found by logging onto <http://www.illinois.gov/KeepCool/SitePages/CoolingCenters.aspx>.
- Do not rely on a fan as your primary cooling device.
- Limit outdoor activity, especially midday when it is the hottest part of the day, and avoid direct sunlight.
- Wear loose, lightweight, light-colored clothing.
- Take cool showers or baths to lower your body temperature.
- Check on at-risk friends, family, and neighbors at least twice a day. These may include seniors and people with chronic health conditions.

#### *Stay Hydrated*

- Drink more water than usual and don’t wait until you’re thirsty to hydrate.
- Drink two to four cups of water every hour while working or exercising outside.
- Avoid alcohol or beverages with high amounts of sugar.

#### *Stay Informed*

- Check the local news for extreme heat warnings.

Normally, the body cools itself by sweating. However, if temperatures and humidity are extremely high, sweating is not effective in maintaining the body's normal temperature. If the body does not cool properly or does not cool enough, a person may suffer a heat-related illness, which can become serious or even deadly if unattended. Warning signs and symptoms vary but may include:

### **Heat Exhaustion**

#### *Symptoms*

- Heavy sweating
- Weakness
- Skin cold, pale, and clammy
  
- Weak pulse
- Fainting and vomiting

### **What You Should Do**

- Move to a cooler location
- Lie down and loosen your clothing
- Apply cool, wet cloths to as much of your body as possible
- Sip water
- If you have vomited and it continues, seek medical attention immediately

### **Heat Stroke**

#### *Symptoms*

- High body temperature (above 103°F)
- Hot, red, dry or moist skin
- Rapid and strong pulse
  
- Possible unconsciousness

### **What You Should Do**

- Call 911 immediately – this is a medical emergency
- Move the person to a cooler location
- Reduce the person's body temperature with cool cloths or a bath
- Do NOT give fluids

People most vulnerable for heat-related illness include the elderly, those who work or exercise outdoors, infants and children, the homeless or poor, and people with a chronic medical condition.

The Illinois Department on Aging encourages relatives and friends to make daily visits or calls to senior citizens living alone. When temperatures and humidity are extremely high, seniors and people with chronic health conditions should be monitored for dehydration and other effects of extreme heat. Additionally, seniors should eat lighter meals, take longer and more frequent rests, and drink plenty of fluids.

Never leave anyone, including pets, alone in a closed, parked vehicle. The air temperature inside a car rises rapidly during hot weather and can lead to brain damage or death.

### **Peoria Public Schools – Update from Superintendent Dr. Sharon Desmoulin-Kherat**

This week, Mayor Ardis launched The Peoria Mayor’s Internship Challenge, an exciting and innovative effort, spearheaded by the Economic Development Council’s Pathways to Prosperity program, to place high school junior and seniors in internships with local businesses. Preparing high school students to be college and career ready is a vital investment in Peoria’s economic growth.

An equally important investment in Peoria’s economic future also launched this week when Valeska Hinton Early Childhood Education Center began its school year housing only three- and four-year-old pre-kindergarten classrooms. The connection between high-quality early childhood education and Peoria’s economic growth may seem less obvious, but it, too, is vitally important.

A 2015 report, *Achieving Kindergarten Readiness for All Our Children*, produced by The Bridgespan Group and Pritzker Children’s Initiative, reports that providing early childhood education for at-risk children can significantly increase their chances of graduating from high school and attending college and decrease their chances of becoming teen parents. The same report points to high-quality early education programs as a factor in reducing children’s lifetime risk factors for chronic diseases including hypertension and high blood sugar. The investment in early childhood education pays off in better education, better health and socio-economic outcomes, increased productivity and less need for social service spending.

The Peoria Public Schools’ investment in early childhood education is increasing as part of its 2016 grade-level reconfiguration plan. Valeska Hinton previously housed pre-K through first grade. Last year, over 450 Peoria children were on a waiting list for pre-K education. The reconfiguration allows the Peoria Public Schools to enroll 430 children in its pre-K program at Valeska Hinton, including district-funded classrooms and PCCEO Headstart and Early Headstart classrooms. PCCEO also operates programs Headstart programs at Harrison Community Learning Center and Manual Academy.



Early childhood education advocate Timothy J. Bartik, author of *Investing in Kids: Early Childhood Programs and Local Economic Development*, writes that “Early childhood education is particularly good at increasing soft skills, which are of great importance to businesses. Much of early childhood education’s long-run effects depend upon its benefits for the development of soft skills, such as the ability to get along with others and with authority figures, and the ability to plan, to defer gratification, and to be self-confident and proactive.”

Valeska Hinton Early Childhood Education Center operates on an alternate schedule so students have more frequent but shorter breaks to prevent the summer-break gap in learning, which can be particularly detrimental to young low-income children. As our youngest Peoria Public School students begin their

educational careers this week, we believe the investment will pay high dividends for the Peoria community.

## WEDNESDAY, JULY 13<sup>TH</sup>




