Mayor's Youth Program Concludes



Nineteen young people were recognized this week for completing the 2016 Mayor's Youth Program, a collaboration between the City of Peoria and Peoria Public Schools. The 8 week program was designed to provide opportunities for Peoria-area youth in the Public Service sector. The program focused on career pathway development and civic engagement by employing Peoria area youth to assist in infrastructure improvements, beautification and clean-up projects throughout the City. Participants interacted with various City Departments while learning about operations and projects. Additional components of the program included life skills development, learning workshops, career pathway lectures and business tours

Peoria Police Department—Night Out Against Crime

The National Night Out Against Crime will be held on Tuesday, August 2nd. Over 40 City of Peoria neighborhoods will join 16,000 communities across the United States to encourage police community partnerships and strengthen neighborhood unity. The purpose of Night Out is to promote neighborhood safety by hosting street parties with food, games, and neighborly interaction. Peoria Public Schools – Update from Superintendent Dr. Sharon Desmoulin-Kherat

The first day of school for Peoria Public School students is just three weeks away. Online registration started this week and by the end of the second day, parents and guardians of more than 1,000 students had already completed online registration through Family Access. For new families or those needing to turn in paperwork, update their address or require assistance, our five regional registration hubs were open two days this week. The hubs, located at Richwoods High School, Peoria High School, Manual Academy, Lincoln K-8 and the Peoria City/County Health Dept., are one way we are making registration easier for families and more efficient for staff. Evening and weekend hours serve working parents. The hubs also will be open Wednesday, August 3 from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. and Saturday, August 6 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Manual Academy's Unity Point Methodist In-School Clinic and the Peoria City/County Health Dept. offer physicals, immunizations and dental exams. Shuttle buses are transporting parents and students from Lincoln K-8, Peoria High School and Richwoods High School to these locations. Translation assistance is available Manual Academy and Lincoln K-8 and the registration hub at Peoria City/County Health Department also will offer a birth certificate retrieval service.

Families also are invited to participate in our annual Backpack Peoria event on Saturday, July 30 at the Dream Center Peoria, 714 Hamilton Blvd., from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Registration and some health services will be available at Backpack Peoria. Students and families also will be able to pick up their school supplies and meet their school principals and assistant principals.

If you don't have a child in our district, your help is needed to "Stuff a Bus" at Northwoods Mall or at the Walmart locations on University and Allen Road. We are very grateful to 98.5 KISS FM, 99.9 WWCT, 96.5 ESPN and 101.1 JACK FM radio stations for supporting this program. A Peoria Public School bus is parked in the center concourse at the mall and we want to stuff it with school supplies, including:

- Pencils, pens, markers, crayons, highlighters, notebooks, loose leaf paper, glue sticks, erasers, scissors, zippered pencil pouches, notecards, pocket folders, zip lock bags, tissue, disinfectant wipes, hand sanitizer
- Cold weather coats, jackets, hats, mittens and gloves
- Solid color polo shirts any color with no logos
- Student uniform pants in navy blue, black or khaki
- Book bags or backpacks

With improved registration procedures, first-day health compliance requirements and the community's help gathering school supplies, Peoria Public School students will be ready to learn on August 17.
