Together, We Can Bring Play Everywhere to Peoria

The state of play is about to change in Peoria. We've been selected as one of 200 finalists in the Play Everywhere Challenge, a \$1 million, national competition to award out-of-the-box ways to make play easy, available, and fun for kids and families—especially for those who lack access to safe, stimulating places today. We've got big ideas to spark kids' imaginations and get their bodies moving here in Peoria, and we're working hard to win the funds to make them happen. But we can dream ever bigger with your help.

What does it mean to bring Play Everywhere to Peoria?

Science and common sense agree: kids need play to grow up healthy, resilient and ready for life.

Evidence shows missing out on the chance to play puts kids at risk for challenges ranging from obesity to anxiety to trouble adjusting in school. Here in Peoria, like the rest of the country, not all kids have the same access to places where they can engage in safe, creative activity.

That status quo isn't the right answer for Peoria. Play is just too important to our kids' healthy development for anyone to be left out.

Earlier this spring, a team including the City of Peoria, Peoria City/County Health Department, and University of Illinois Extension got together to find new ways to bring play into the lives of Peoria's children—especially for those who need it most—because we know that's key to making our community a great place to grow up. Based upon the foundational assessment of play opportunities in the Southside by a group of students from the University of Illinois School of Architecture, an application to transform several vacant lots in the Southside was submitted. We were selected as a finalist out of over 1,000 applications nationwide. If we're named as one of the 50 winners this fall, we'll break ground starting in fall 2016. A big thank you goes out to Elisa Laurini, Claire McDermott, Kristen Reifschneider, and Elsa Reifsteck for their work in assessing the area and developing concepts for reintroducing play in these *Lots of Fun!*

How can you get involved?

We know more places to play builds better bonds—among kids, neighbors, and communities—and those relationships are the foundation for communities that thrive. Our proposal to create *Lots of Fun!* is a modest but mighty boost to kids' chances to get active and creative in Peoria. If we're selected as a winner, we hope it will be just the beginning of a larger effort to make play a way of life in everyday and unexpected places – sidewalks, vacant lots, bus stops, open streets. And we're confident our idea isn't just a great solution for Peoria. It could be a bellwether for other communities across the nation who want to change the state of play for kids and families.

Peoria Public Schools – Update from Superintendent Dr. Sharon Desmoulin-Kherat

With the Independence Day holiday weekend behind us, preparations for the next academic year take on extra urgency for the Peoria Public Schools team.

Within the next week, we will be mailing out Back-to-School packets to returning families. The content also is available at www.peoriapublicschools.org/enrollment.

All students need the help, involvement and guidance of caring adults in their lives to succeed academically. There are many positive actions parents and guardians can take to help our teachers and district staff achieve the results we all want to see. For example:

- Attendance – It is so very important that every child attend every class, every day with the exception of illness. We will be communicating with families throughout the year about the importance of attendance.
- Reading – we have encouraged parents all summer to read with their children every day for 30 minutes. Reading, like nearly everything in life, becomes easier, more fun and more rewarding the more you do it. When children stop reading for extended periods of time, they often take backwards steps in their reading ability. Keep reading!
- Attend Parent University each month, become active in your school’s Parent – Teacher Organization and log onto Career Cruising and Compass Learning with your child.

We have made some exciting changes to our student enrollment process this year to help families be ready for the first day of school, August 17. First, we are opening five regional registration hubs at Manual Academy, Peoria High School, Richwoods High School, Lincoln K–8 and the Peoria City/County Health Department. The registration hubs will be open on Tuesday, July 26, Thursday, July 28 and Wednesday, August 3, from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. The registration hubs will also be open on Saturday, August 6 from 9 a.m. until 1 p.m. The Manual Academy and Lincoln K-8 hubs will offer translation services.

Manual Academy In-School Clinic and the Peoria City/County Health Department also will offer physical exams, immunizations and dental exams during the registration hub hours. The Peoria High School and

Richwoods High School registration hubs will offer shuttle service to the Peoria City/County Health Department and to the Manual Academy In-School Clinic to help families meet the physical and immunization requirements. All students must have up-to-date health, dental and vision exams on the first day of school, August 17. The additional dates and longer hours of the five registration hubs will enable families to meet the First Day Compliance requirements.

All families are welcome to register at the registration hubs. Returning families also can register online by logging on to Skyward Family Access from Monday, July 25 through Sunday, August 16 at midnight.

Families also are invited to participate in our annual Backpack Peoria event on Saturday, July 30 at the Dream Center Peoria, 714 Hamilton Blvd., from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Registration and some health services will be available at Backpack Peoria. Students and families also will be able to pick up their school supplies and meet their school principals and assistant principals.

If you would like to help Peoria Public School students gather needed school supplies, we invite you to bring donations to Northwoods Mall beginning Monday, July 11. Look for the school bus parked in the center concourse and help us "Stuff a Bus" with school supplies for our students.
