**Peoria's City Hall In The Finals For "Most Beautiful City Hall"**

Peoria's City Hall is in the finals of a national competition, competing for the title of "Most Beautiful City Hall" against Vancouver, Washington. The sponsor of the contest, Engaging Local Government Leaders (ELGL), aims to connect people from different areas in government. This is the inaugural contest for the honor.

People can vote favorite via social media channels. There are multiple ways to participate and vote. From any computer or device, go to [bit.ly/votepeoria](http://bit.ly/votepeoria), cast your vote. Additional votes are counted by making a comment, accessible by clicking the "view comments" link at the bottom of the voting box, for an additional vote. Take a selfie with Peoria's City Hall as the backdrop, tag #ELGLCityHall and #cityhallselfie, and get two extra votes. Photos may be posted to Twitter (@CityofPeoria\_IL), Facebook (Peoriaill) or Instagram (city\_of\_peoria). Voting may be done once a day, per device. A positive comment equals a vote, as does a Tweet using #ELGLCityHall.

The winner will receive a membership to ELGL, the prestigious Leslie B. Knope Trophy, of television series' Parks & Recreation fame and extreme bragging rights for this national recognition.

This bracket-style competition pitted Peoria against city halls from Kenmore, WA, Kansas City, MO, Kannapolis, NC and Effingham, IL. Last week's win over Pasadena, CA was a true nail biter, with over 23,731 votes cast and 2,017 comments posted. Peoria won by less than 200 votes. No small feat since the exterior of Pasadena's City Hall serves as the city hall in Pawnee, In featured in the Parks & Recreation television series. Votes may be cast from all over the world.

Stacy Peterson, Communication Specialist for the City of Peoria, is ecstatic about the support and recognition for the 118 year old City Hall. She stated, "Peoria's City Hall is truly the embodiment of history, government and art represented in a building for the people." She continued, "The outpouring of support and engagement from across the country has been

overwhelming. Peorians recognize City Hall as a treasure and we would love to bring home the title.” Voting for the finals end this Friday at 10:59 pm. More information about ELGL may be found at ELGL.org. Check the City of Peoria’s social media channels for links, photos and daily updates.

### **City of Peoria to Host Small Group Discussions**

The City of Peoria recently scheduled two Community Conversations on Race and Economic Opportunity with over 400 people participating in the combined sessions. Out of these discussions, several areas of interest were determined:

- *Asset Development* (Improving financial literacy, increasing income tax credits, improving credit, building savings, home ownership strategies)
- *Workforce Development* (Achieving self-sufficiency through skills development, job placement, job retention, job advancement)
- *Economic Development* (Increasing opportunity through growth in the economy)
- Infrastructure (Ensuring infrastructure investments create multiple benefits and factor in the needs of all communities)
- *Justice* (Improving educational outcomes and reducing barriers for persons with a history of involvement with the criminal justice system)
- *Health* (Improving health outcomes correlated with high poverty)
- *Education* (Increasing education attainment, reducing barriers to attainment and completion)

Workgroups have been scheduled for the above topics. Participants will work with city staffers to gather ideas and form actionable plans that can be considered in the city’s budget process.

During the networking session several attendees spoke with the City of Peoria Purchasing Manager and requested a time to meet to further discuss opportunities.





Community Development Department Participates in the Woman and Minority Construction Trades Career Fair - Community Development Staff members participated in the 4th Annual Woman and Minority Construction Trades Career Fair on March 4th, 2017 at the Woodruff Career and Technical School. Neighborhood Enhancement Coordinator Terence Acquah and Code Enforcement Supervisor Ashley Elias discussed the multiple positions that exist in the Community Development Department and explained the core functions of the Department. ### **Peoria Public Schools—Update from Superintendent Desmoulin-Kherat**

Like many Peoria citizens, I have been following the Most Beautiful City Hall national competition and hoping that as of Friday, March 10, The Peoria City Hall will be voted the winner.

Among its many beautiful and aesthetically pleasing attributes, the Peoria City Hall regularly houses rotating displays of the artwork of Peoria Public School student artists. This month, display cases on the third and fourth floors feature artwork by Von Steuben Middle School and Lincoln K-8 students and

watercolor and acrylic paintings by Richwoods High School students hang in the third floor hallway. Please take the time to visit city hall and view the work of these talented young people.

The creative artistry of Peoria Public School students also is on display this month just two blocks from City Hall at the Peoria Public Library Main Street location. The second floor gallery in the library currently houses the Peoria Public Schools Budding Artists exhibition, featuring works by students from every Peoria Public School, from pre-kindergarten through high school. The Budding Artist exhibition opened on March 2 and will continue through March 28.

Fine arts also will be the focus of next week's Parent University, on Thursday, March 16, 5 to 8 p.m. at the Peoria Public Library Main branch. This month's Parent University is hosted by Roosevelt Magnet School and Peoria High School and highlights the Peoria Public Schools' exemplary and expanding fine arts programming. Each floor of the library will feature performances by choral groups, dance troupes, orchestras, bands and drama performances.

As you may recall, in spring 2016 our District began a focused effort to strengthen fine arts programming at all grade levels. This effort included recruiting additional students for arts programs at Roosevelt Magnet School and for the Preparatory School for the Arts (PSA) at Peoria High School and a successful drive for donations of gently-used musical instruments. The results of our renewed focus on music, drama, dance and the visual arts will be on display at Parent University on March 16. Please join us!

In other news, I am excited to announce that Richwoods High School alum and Chicago Bears cornerback and special teams player Sherrick McManis will be presenting the Peoria Public Schools with a \$25,000 grant on Friday, March 10 at 2:10 p.m. at Richwoods High School.

The former RHS football player and state champion long jumper will present the grant on behalf of the NFL Foundation to the athletic directors, coaches and players of all three Peoria Public Schools' high school football programs. Each football program will receive \$8,333 to be used for athletic training services, including concussion equipment and prevention training.

The NFL Foundation's Club Matching Certified Athletic Trainer Grant matches dollars donated by the Chicago Bears organization for athletic training services provided by Athletico. The Peoria Public Schools has partnered with Athletico for four years.

The state-of-the-art equipment and training provided by NFL Foundation, the Chicago Bears and Athletico is vital for keeping Peoria Public Schools student-athletes injury-free.
