**Office Of the City Manager-Community Discussion on Race Work Group Sign Up**

Thank you to the participants of our two community conversations. 1,362 ideas were generated by the participants of the December 6 meeting. City staff identified initial areas to group the ideas and create work groups.

- Economic Development (Increasing opportunity through growth in the economy)
- Infrastructure (Ensuring infrastructure investments create multiple benefits and factor in the needs of all communities)
- Justice (Improving educational outcomes and reducing barriers for persons with a history of involvement with the criminal justice system)
- Health (Improving health outcomes correlated with high poverty)
- Education (Increasing education attainment, reducing barriers to attainment and completion)

### **Emergency Communications Center—CodeRED Testing**

In an event of an emergency, City of Peoria/Peoria County officials issue alerts through CodeRED, a high-speed notification solution. The CodeRED system allows messages to be quickly delivered to targeted areas of Peoria/Peoria County or to the city and county as a whole. On February 15, 2017, the Emergency Communications Center of Peoria/Peoria County will be conducting a performance test of the system from 10:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m., contacting everyone in Peoria/Peoria County who is currently in the emergency database. Receiving a test message will assure that residents will receive a message when an actual alert is issued by City/County officials. Residents who have not enrolled to receive emergency CodeRED notifications, or did not receive a test message should immediately visit the city of county websites and click the CodeRED logo to enroll.

David Tuttle, Manager of the ECC, stated, “No one should automatically assume that the Emergency Communications Center has your contact information.” He urges all individuals and businesses to visit [www.peoriagov.org](http://www.peoriagov.org) or [www.peoriacounty.org](http://www.peoriacounty.org) and click on the CodeRED link. Those without Internet access may call the Emergency Communications Center Customer Service Center (309-494-8065), Monday through Friday, (8AM-5PM) to supply their information over the phone. Required information includes first and last name, street address (physical address, no P.O. boxes), city, state, zip code, and primary phone number, additional phone numbers can be entered as well.

### **Community Development – Home Accessibility Program Grant**

The Illinois Housing Development Authority (IHDA) announced that the City of Peoria Community Development Department was awarded \$144,450 in competitive grant funds for the Affordable Housing Trust Fund Home Accessibility Program (HAP). This program provides accessibility modifications to houses for very low income elderly or disabled residents. The goal of the program is to prevent premature or unnecessary institutionalization of senior citizens and persons with disabilities by funding repairs that will allow residents to remain in their homes. Participants must meet all IHDA eligibility requirements including IHDA income limits. It is anticipated that the IHDA funds and participant applications will be available in May. ### **Community Development - 2017 CDBG Roof Program**

The Community Development Department will hold a lottery for the 18 available openings for the 2017 CDBG Roof Program on Wednesday, March 22 at 10 am. The entry period for the lottery will open on Wednesday, March 1 at 8 am and close on Wednesday, March 15 at 5 pm. Applicants may come to City Hall Room 300 at any time during regular business hours from 8 am to 5 pm to submit a household for the lottery by completing an entry form. Entries may also be submitted during evening hours on March 8 from 5 to 7 pm. Entrants are not required to be present at the lottery. The first 18 selected entries will have one week to submit all required documentation before moving on to the next household on the list. There is a limit of one entry per household, but no limit to the total number of households that may enter the lottery. Households must meet all CDBG eligibility criteria including owning the home for at least one year, meeting HUD income limits, and having homeowners insurance. An informational session about the lottery process will be held on Wednesday, February 22 at 5:30 pm at City Hall Room 404. **Community Development—Campaign Signs**

Political and/or Campaign signs are regulated by the City of Peoria Sign Ordinance. These signs are considered temporary and do not require an application or permit. However, there are specific performance standards that must be met.

1. In Residential zoning districts, the sign cannot exceed 8 square feet. In non-Residential zoning districts, the sign cannot exceed 32 square feet.
2. There is no limit on the number of signs that may be placed on an individual property.
3. Signs cannot be placed on the public right-of-way (generally the area between the sidewalk and street). This would also include attaching signs to stop signs, light poles, or other public infrastructure.

### **Peoria Public Schools—Update from Superintendent Desmoulin-Kherat**

It is difficult to overstate the transformative effect books have on children. Reading for enjoyment opens new worlds, validates a child's perspective and feelings, engenders empathy, requires a mental investment unmatched by screen time and provides calm, quiet recreation.

During February, The Peoria Public Schools and the Peoria Public Library are collaborating on three projects to introduce children to wonderful books.

Projects at Manual Academy and Peoria High School introduce high school students to the fiction of two award-winning authors known for their portrayals of diverse characters and to the authors themselves.

Newberry Medal-winning author Matt de la Peña will speak to Manual Academy students at an assembly on Thursday, February 9 at 1:45 p.m.

Since the fall, through a program funded by a grant from the Dollar General Store foundation, Manual Academy 9<sup>th</sup> graders have been reading De la Peña's *Ball Don't Lie* and *I Will Save You*. De la Peña's fiction for children and young adults is recognized for working-class, multicultural characters and its appeal to reluctant readers. Manual Academy English/Language Arts teacher Mary Jo Newman-Evans has been assisted in presenting De la Peña's fiction by Bradley University teacher education students. These future educators in Dr. Melinda McBee Orzulak's Teaching Reading and Literacy class are gaining valuable experience working with high school students. The grant funding provided a copy of *I Will Save You* for each student in Newman-Evans' class which De La Peña will be signing on Thursday.

De La Peña earned his BA from the University of the Pacific, where he attended school on a full athletic scholarship for basketball and his MFA from San Diego State University. In addition to speaking at Manual, he will speak at 4:30 p.m. at the Lincoln Branch of the Peoria Public Library and a 7:30 p.m. at Bradley University Alumni Center Peplow Pavilion.

Meanwhile, the Peoria High School Pride Book Club is reading the Peoria Public Library Peoria Reads! current selection, *Silver Sparrow* by Tayari Jones. Like much of Jones' fiction, *Silver Sparrow* tells stories of black middle class families in Atlanta.

*Silver Sparrow* was nominated for an NAACP Image Award. Jones is a recipient of a Lifetime Achievement Award in Fine Arts from the Congressional Black Caucus Foundation. Jones is a graduate of Spelman College, The University of Iowa and Arizona State University. She has taught at Prairie View A&M University, East Tennessee State University, The University of Illinois and George Washington University. In addition, she has led workshops in Portugal, Ghana, Uganda, and Brazil. Currently, she is an Associate Professor in the MFA program at Rutgers-Newark University.

Jones will visit Peoria High School on February 24 at noon to speak to students and sign books. She also will appear at the Peoria Public Library Lincoln Branch and North Branch.

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Finally, the Hines Primary School library and the Peoria Public Library are collaborating on an unusual effort to encourage students to read. Barbers Love Books encourages area barbers to serve as reading mentors for kindergarten through 8<sup>th</sup> grade students. On Friday, February 10, the Peoria Public Library and Hines School will deliver crates of 25 books to six local barber shops. Children who read a book while waiting their turn or while they are in the barber chair will receive a \$1-\$2 discount on their haircut. The book collections will be rotated every four to six weeks. Barbers Love Books is the brainchild of Hines Primary School library manager Kris Coker-Schlink and based on a similar program she observed in Michigan. Locations include: Peoria Barber College – Shon Allen, LifeStylz – Jose Rodriguez, Kuttin Up – Quame Lobdell, Headz Up, Great Clips Metro Center, and Judy’s on Sheridan.

Encouraging children to read is a constant effort of the Peoria Public Schools. Each month, Franklin Primary School hosts Real Men Read, bringing professional men into school to read to students. The District is always trying to expand our league of Reading Buddies to visit classrooms and read with students on a monthly basis. The all-volunteer Look! It’s My Book! donates six books a year to our K – 4 students to keep for their home library. These combined efforts are helping build lifetime readers and learners.



# 2017 CDBG ROOF PROGRAM LOTTERY

The City of Peoria Community Development Department is holding a lottery for eligible homeowners for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) roof replacement program.
