Public Works City Gathering Public Input for Solid Waste Collection

The City of Peoria is asking residents to share their thoughts on potential enhancements for solid waste collection. The City of Peoria is conducting a survey focused on solid waste collection including trash, recycling, yard waste, bulky waste and other materials.

2. A public meeting will be hosted on Monday, February 27, 2017, at 6:00 p.m. at Valeska Hinton Early Childhood Education Center at 800 W Romeo B. Garrett Ave., Peoria, IL 61605.
3. If recycling or other solid waste collection services are enhanced, there may be increased costs to Peoria residents. This survey will also help gauge the public's willingness to financially support waste collection improvements.

This survey will help the City of Peoria evaluate program performance and potential upgrades to service levels for the next round of service procurement.

Initial suggestions for waste collection improvement include extending the yard waste season and increasing the frequency of recycling collection, among others.

"It's imperative that residents share feedback on solid waste collection for future decision-making," said Public Works Director Scott Reeise. "We want to make sure everyone's needs are being met and that we're making Peoria both financially and environmentally sustainable."

Peoria Public Schools—Update from Superintendent Desmoulin-Kherat

The summer months are a mixed blessing for educators, students and their families. The lazy, relaxed, warm days we anticipate during the winter can quickly become a time of boredom for children and a source of stress for families seeking a safe, reliable and affordable environment for students. Educators, meanwhile, use valuable instructional time when school begins in August reviewing material children have forgotten since spring.

Beginning this summer, the Peoria Public Schools will offer summer school to all students. The Monday-Thursday full-day program will include breakfast and lunch. Morning hours will focus on academic instruction and afternoon hours will be devoted to physical fitness and fine arts activities including soccer, dance, art, golf, tennis, field trips and guest speakers. Students must participate in the morning sessions to participate in the afternoon sessions. The summer school day will begin at 8:15 a.m. and end at 4 p.m.

Kindergarten through 2nd grade students can choose to enroll in morning reading instruction during June and morning math instruction during July or they can enroll in both sessions.

Third through 8th grade students will focus on science workshops and individualized online instruction during the morning hours. This program runs from June 5 through July 27.

In addition, an accelerated algebra I program will be offered to 20 students currently in 7th grade. These students will work on algebra I concepts with both personal and online instruction. This program will be limited to 20 students.

As in past summers, English Language Learners (ELL) students in grades 1 – 8 will gather at Glen Oak Community Learning Center. Locations for the other programs are still being finalized.

Taking advantage of the Summer School options can make a vast difference in a child's academic progress during the school year. I encourage families to visit www.peoriapublicschools.org/summerschool for details and to register online.

Community Development— Training Session for Landlords and Non-Owner Occupied Property Owners

Each year the Community Development Department hosts a training session for landlords and non-owner occupied property owners. These sessions include multiple speakers from the City and other interested groups. The time is utilized to inform property owners of programs they are eligible for, as well as a reminder of their rights and responsibilities. This year, representatives from PHA reviewed their new inspection process related to the Housing Choice Voucher Program, the Peoria City/County Health Department reviewed the Lead Abatement Program, and the Peoria Friendship House discussed their Rapid Rehousing Program. In addition, City representatives and the Peoria Police Department discussed how landlords can be a bigger part of the neighborhoods they own property in and went into detail about property maintenance and the code compliance process. The training sessions were held at three different times with approximately 1,400 in attendance. On March 30th, 2017, the Community Development Department will be holding a similar session geared towards tenants. More information regarding that program will be released in the next few weeks.
