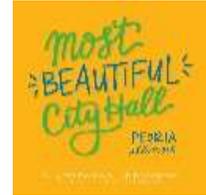

Community Development-City to Hold Lottery for CDBG Roof Program Applications

20 available openings for 2019

On February 13, the City of Peoria will hold a lottery for the available funds in the 2019 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Roof Program. This annual program assists low income homeowners who are unable to afford needed roof repairs. There are 20 openings for the roof program this year.

Beginning Monday, January 28 at 8:00 a.m., interested applicants may come to City Hall, 419 Fulton Street, Room 300 during regular business hours from 8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. and 1:30 pm to 4:30 p.m. to submit a household for the lottery by completing an entry form. The lottery closes on Friday, February 8 at 4:30 p.m. Entry forms may only be submitted in person.

The lottery drawing will be held on Wednesday, February 13 at 11:00 a.m. in City Hall, Room 400. Entrants are not required to be present. All entrants will be contacted via phone or mail by staff members in the days following the drawing.

The first 20 selected entries in the lottery will have one week to submit an application with all the required documentation. If the appropriate documentation is not submitted within the week, city staff will contact the next household on the list. There is a limit of one entry per household.

To be eligible for the program, households must have an adjusted gross income at or below 80% of the area median income by household size, as calculated by HUD. The current income limit for a household of four people is \$60,950.

Applicants must also meet all other CDBG eligibility requirements including owning the home for at least one year, passing an interior and exterior inspection, and having active homeowners insurance. Peoria Public Schools – Update from Superintendent Dr. Sharon Desmoulin-Kherat

A 2016 study by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics ranked 200 careers based on job environment, income, outlook and stress. Four of the top ten career categories were directly related to math: data scientist (#1), statistician (#2), mathematician (#6) and actuary (#10).

Job growth for mathematicians and statisticians is expected to grow by 33 percent before 2026. In 2017, the median annual pay for these jobs is \$84,760.

On Saturday morning, January 19, approximately 60 Peoria Public School 7th and 8th grade students will gather at Lindbergh Middle School for our annual MathCounts competition. The students – referred to as Mathletes – represent nine schools and spend the morning competing in individual and team testing events and math-based games and contests.

PPS MathCounts Mathletes have the basic foundational mathematical skills to advance through high school Algebra I, II and III; Geometry, Calculus and Statistics. Their math skills will qualify them to register for Peoria Public School courses in digital engineering, computer science, CISCO networking, hardware infrastructure, programming and web development. Students who complete many of these courses receive dual credit from Illinois Center College (ICC), so they graduate from high school with credit hours that likely would have cost their families hundreds of dollars. Even if PPS Mathletes choose to pursue a

career area which does not directly involve mathematics, by excelling at math they have built invaluable critical thinking and analytical skills.

Susan Gobeyn, Peoria Public Schools Science and Math Coordinator, relies on Peoria Public School staff members who take extra time to coach the teams after school and to manage the event on Saturday. We also rely on sponsors from the community, including Peoria Park District, Avanti's Ristorante, Taco Bell, Sonic, Peoria Rivermen, Peoria Chiefs and Smoothie King.

At the closing MathCounts awards ceremony, we recognize the top two teams from each of the high school region and the top team overall; champions from the sprint, target and Individual rounds; and one student from each team receives a Best of Team award. It is wonderful to recognize these students who put such effort and achieve in an academic area that not only does not receive accolades, but that many students and even adults shy away from.

Good luck to our Peoria Public School student Mathletes and their coaches!
