

Peoria Public Schools – Update from Superintendent Dr. Sharon Desmoulin-Kherat

Richwoods High School's International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma program will mark its 20th year in 2022. The IB program (officially spelled *programme* due to its European roots) is a rigorous college preparatory course of study recognized across the globe for its high standards of academic excellence.

The program curriculum focuses on developing graduates with a broad range of human capacities and responsibilities beyond just academic success, committed to helping all members of the school community learn to respect themselves, others, and the world around them.

More specifically, the IB Learner Profile develops students who are: inquirers, knowledgeable, thinkers, communicators, principled, open-minded, caring, risk-takers, balanced and reflective.

Typically, Richwoods High School IB students graduate with numerous college credits and often attend the nation's most prestigious institutions, including the University of Illinois, Ivy League universities, West Point, and the U.S. Naval Academy.

Richwoods High School remains the only Illinois public high school outside of metropolitan Chicago to offer an IB program.

Applications are now being accepted for 2022-2023 incoming freshmen. Eighth-grade students from PPS schools, private/parochial or home-schooled students may apply for the program if they live within the Peoria Public Schools district boundaries. The application deadline is Friday, November 19. Applicants are required to provide their grade school transcripts and letters of recommendation from teachers.

Peoria Public School middle school principals and counselors also have applications and are making announcements about the program.

This summary document is produced on a weekly basis. It is used as an agenda for the City Development Review Board and as a transparency tool to allow the public to be aware of development in Peoria.

1. Summary Information

- **One Stop Shop** is held every Monday at 1:30 PM in City Hall. This is a free service for anyone who wants to discuss development with staff from various City departments, local utility companies, the Health Department, and CityLink.
- **Development Center Permits** can typically be issued immediately and/or do not require an extensive review period. These permits include most trade (electrical, plumbing, HVAC, etc.) permits, repair permits, new single-family residential construction, alteration/additions, and demolitions.
- Each permit application includes a self-reported value of the project. The **Total Value of Development (YTD)** is the sum of these reported values.

2. Development Review Board Projects

- The **Development Review Board** is a group of City staff, local utility representatives, and other local government agencies that review and comment on more complex development applications and cases that are required to go to a public hearing.
- A **Job** is a development application that requires multiple departments to review for compliance but does not require a public hearing or City Council review.
- A **Project** is a development application that requires multiple departments to review for compliance and requires a public hearing before a City Commission and in some cases, a final decision by the City Council.
- The **Staff Assigned** to each Job or Project is the primary contact person for any inquires.
