**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed proposals will be received at the Office of the City Stormwater Engineer, Public Works Facility, 3505 N. Dries Lane, Peoria, Illinois, until **11:00 A.M., Tuesday, December 8, 2020**, for the proposed project officially known as **ABINGTON STREET AND MADISON AVENUE PIPE CULVERT REPLACEMENT**, at which time said proposals will be publicly opened and read.

The proposed improvement consists of the replacement of the drainage structure parallel to Abington that connects to the railroad structure. The existing pipe culvert will be removed to allow for construction of a new 96" PCC culvert pipe with a concrete headwall and junction chamber. New concrete curb and gutter will be constructed along Abington Street. A new inlet will be added that outlets to the proposed pipe end section. Regrade and restore the construction area.

Plans, proposal forms and specifications for the proposed project may be examined at the Office of the City Stormwater Engineer, Public Works Facility, 3505 North Dries Lane, Peoria, IL. Before plans and specifications may be obtained, contractors must be pre-qualified. Complete sets of plans and proposal forms may be obtained electronically by emailing a request for plans to [pwdropbox@peoriagov.org](mailto:pwdropbox@peoriagov.org). All proposals must be accompanied by cash, certified check, cashier's check or a bid bond for not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond for the full amount of the contract, with sureties, to be approved by the City Stormwater Engineer. **Compliance with the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act is required under this contract.**

The City of Peoria reserves the right to waive technicalities and to reject any or all proposals.
