



PROGRAM OVERVIEW

- The city of Peoria Public Works Paint a Plow program allows Peoria organizations to paint a Peoria Public Works snowplow blade with messages of winter, snow and ice safety, City or community pride or patriotism.
- The community outreach campaign is designed to build morale and raise awareness for the city of Peoria Public Works Department's winter operations all year long.
- The Department reaches out to schools, art classes, nonprofits and after school programs within the City to paint the blades with original artwork (messages and designs must be original, tasteful and contain no profanity, vulgarity, political or partisan messages).
- In addition to being seen in full-service during the winter weather months, the blades may be used at events within the community to enhance public awareness, promote safety and foster greater appreciation of both the city of Peoria Public Works Department and the community.
- When participants have completed their work, the blades will be mounted to a plow truck and used to fight snow and winter weather.

Rules and Guidelines:

Messages and designs must be participants' original work and be tasteful and contain no profanity, vulgarity, political or partisan messages.
