Community Development Department -2020 CDBG Roof Program

The Community Development Department will hold a lottery for the 20 openings in the 2020 CDBG Roof Program. Interested applicants must come to City Hall, 419 Fulton Street, Room 203 (Development Center) during regular business hours (8:00 am to 5:00 pm) to submit for the lottery by completing an entry form.

The lottery will open on **Monday, February 3rd at 8:00 am** and close on **Friday, February 21st at 5:00 pm**. The lottery drawing will be held on **Tuesday, February 25th at 10:00 am** in City Hall Room 400 (City Council Chambers). Entrants are not required to be present.

The first 20 selected entries in the lottery must submit an application with all the required documentation by **5:00 pm on Friday, March 6th**. If the appropriate documentation is not submitted by that time, City staff will contact the next household on the list. There is a limit of one entry per household, but there is no limit to the total number of households that may enter the lottery.

An application help session will be held on **Tuesday, March 3rd at 5:30 pm** in Room 307 of City Hall. Applicants must meet all eligibility requirements, including owning the home for at least one year, passing an interior and exterior inspection, and having active homeowners insurance. Recreational Cannabis Legalization– Issues Submission - Week of January 6, 2020 With the legalization of recreational cannabis going into effect January 1, 2020, Peoria Police took the opportunity to provide public education with the do's and don'ts of what is allowed under Illinois State Statute. Beginning December 30, 2019, a public service announcement was rolled out on the PPD Facebook page and a follow-up PSA video on January 3, 2020. The objective is to educate individuals choosing to partake in recreational cannabis and provide them with the information they need to partake legally, responsibly, and within the law.

Peoria Public Schools – Update from Superintendent Dr. Sharon Desmoulin-Kherat

The Peoria Public Schools Foundation hosted its fifth annual 365 Breakfast at Woodruff Career and Technical Center (WCTC) this week. We were particularly excited to welcome Dr. Marquita Furness Davis, a Manual High School alum and deputy director of early learning for the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation.

Dr. Furness-Davis spoke of her experiences at Manual High School, where she was a cheerleader and member of the student council among many other pursuits. An advocate for public education – particularly her own public education in Peoria – she told the audience that her success would not have been possible without the learning experiences offered at Peoria Public Schools. She says the Peoria district has produced highly successful professionals in a wide variety of fields, who have achieved success throughout the world.

The 365 Breakfast encourages guests to pledge at least \$1 a day to support the PPS Foundation programs. It gives Foundation president Cindy Morris and her staff the opportunity to tell the story of the wonderful work they do engaging individuals, organizations and businesses to work with Peoria Public School students. PPS Foundation programs include:

- **Classroom, Innovation, Stem and Field Experience Grants.** Peoria Public School teachers and staff can apply for annual multiple grant offerings for enhanced experiences in and outside the classroom.
- **Student scholarships.** The PPS Foundation provides money for college and summer camp scholarships to assist students in furthering their education and career readiness.
- **Horizons Program.** For seven years now, the Horizons Club exposes students to professionals working in a wide range of careers in a weekly meeting for career and college readiness education.
- **Adopt-A-School.** This 30-year program in our school district has been overseen by the PPS Foundation now for the last four years. The program has new endeavors such as the Making the Grade Conferences and the Little Free Pantries, Little Free Libraries, and expanded Snack Pack Programming.
- **Basic Need Support.** The PPS Foundation provides uniform and clothing needs for all students plus emergency support for families that experience hardships and beyond.

The breakfast also gives us a chance to showcase the outstanding talents of Woodruff Culinary Arts students who prepare a delicious breakfast for the event.
