

COVID-19 Daily Numbers Return



Beginning this week the COVID-19 cases for our community will be posted on the City of Peoria [Facebook page](#), the Peoria County Facebook page and the Peoria City/County Health Department Facebook page. These numbers will be reported Monday-Friday.

City Manager's Office—Seeking Public Input for Coronavirus Rescue Plan Funds

The Federal Government has allocated \$350 Billion for state and local governments of the \$1.9 trillion American Rescue Plan. Over the next two years, the City of Peoria will receive \$47,089,976 in Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (FRF). Last month, the City received the first \$23,544,988. The City Council voted in June to use \$10,301,585 of the FRF to eliminate the need to issue working cash bonds in 2021, and to curtail furloughs for affected non-union employees. \$36,788,391 remains to be obligated by December 31, 2024.

Congress outlined specific funding objectives:

- **Support urgent COVID-19 response efforts** to continue to decrease the spread of the virus and bring the pandemic under control.
- **Replace lost public sector revenue** to strengthen support for vital public services and help retain jobs
- **Support immediate economic stabilization** for households and businesses
- **Address systemic public health and economic challenges** that have contributed to the inequal impact of the pandemic

Within these objectives, Congress and the Treasury Department outlined several areas of allowable expenditures:

- **Support Public Health Response**
- **Address Negative Economic Impacts**
- **Replace Public Sector Revenue Loss**
- **Premium Pay for Workers**
- **Water and Sewer Infrastructure**
- **Broadband Infrastructure**

Since the pandemic has disproportionately impacted low-income families and communities of color, the FRF provides for additional flexibility for equity-focused services:

- Additional flexibility for the hardest-hit communities and families to address health disparities, invest in housing, address educational disparities, and promote healthy childhood environments
- Broadly applicable to Qualified Census Tracts, other disproportionately impacted areas, and when provided by Tribal governments

There are specific prohibited uses of the funds:

- Changes that reduce net tax revenue
- Extraordinary payments into a pension fund
- Rainy day fund deposits
- Funding debt service

City Manager’s Office—Masks Required in City Buildings



On August 3, 2021, based on guidance from the Peoria City/County Health Department, CDC, and IDPH, new COVID-19 protocols were issued for staff and visitors to City buildings.

As of July 28, 2021, Peoria County entered the *substantial transmission level* for the spread of COVID-19 (“COVID”). Surrounding communities have also entered into substantial or high transmission levels. Peoria County’s positivity rate has generally increased daily since July 1, 2021, when the rate was at 1.0% compared to August 1, 2021, when Peoria County’s positivity rate was reported at 5.33%.

Peoria Public Works-Mayor’s Youth Program Makes Their Mark on Peoria’s Green Infrastructure

All good things must come to an end, including Peoria’s life-changing summer work program for teens. The Mayor’s Youth Program concluded on Friday, July 30, with a congratulatory closing celebration at Twin Towers Plaza.



The small but mighty crew of 13 student workers and five leaders had a jam-packed schedule this year with several accomplishments to boot. Their wide range of assignments leaped from litter and tire pickup to weeding, landscaping, sodding, and overhauling the City's Well Farm and Voris Field. The outcomes have made a strong impact on the neighborhoods where the teens devoted their time and energy.

"I always tell them, everything we touch as a program needs to turn to gold," said Program Coach, Demetrius Edwards. "I'm extremely proud of this group for their teamwork and all they've accomplished this summer."

Edwards serves as a teacher and coach at Peoria Public Schools and has helped facilitate the summer work program for the past several years. Under his watch, students learned about what it means to be a hard worker, a strong team player, and a respectable member of our community. And while the types of work and projects might change year over year, the program messaging continues to hold steady.

"We aim to address the whole person . . . not just the teen or student – but what it means to be a member of the workforce and a productive member of society," said Edwards.

This year's program would not have been possible without the collaboration between the City and Peoria Public Schools. Together the partnership helped shape the high schoolers and recent college grads into better people too, with some students saying they now have a broader outlook on life and are more accepting of others.

"I'm going to really miss this program," said Mayor's Youth Program student worker, Joshua Johnson. "It was a highlight of my summer . . . the best highlight of my summer."



Peoria Public Works-Peoria Public Works Rolls Out 'Paint a Plow' Campaign

The warm summer sun may have chilly winter snow far from your mind, but a new initiative created in 2020 by the Peoria Public Works Department will have you thinking of the cold season well before it hits.

The [Paint a Plow](#) program aims to educate residents of all ages about some of the best practices drivers and pedestrians should follow when encountering snowplows on Peoria roads.

Participants build a sense of community and engage in discussions surrounding winter weather safety when painting winter safety messaging on a City snowplow blade. Then, come late fall, the art-covered blades will be mounted to a plow truck and used by Public Works to fight snow throughout the winter season.

“Over the years we’ve seen a lot of hesitation and concerning driving behaviors when motorists encounter snowplows or approach our salt trucks,” said Public Works Deputy Director of Operations, Sie Maroon. “We often promote work zone safety reminders, but we rarely talk about how motorists should adapt their driving around our wintertime machinery.”

The program is open to Peoria schools and nonprofit organizations. Peoria Public Works is accepting applications for summer/fall 2021 now through mid-September 2021. Those who are interested should review the program overview and complete an application and participation waiver that can be found on the city of Peoria website. “We hope this program gets the safety conversation going early on, before snow hits,” said Maroon. “Everyone needs to know how to safely interact with our snow fighters. This should help.”

This summary document is produced on a weekly basis. It is used as an agenda for the City Development Review Board and as a transparency tool to allow the public to be aware of development in Peoria.

1. Summary Information

- **One Stop Shop** is held every Monday at 1:30 PM in City Hall. This is a free service for anyone who wants to discuss development with staff from various City departments, local utility companies, the Health Department, and CityLink.
- **Development Center Permits** can typically be issued immediately and/or do not require an extensive review period. These permits include most trade (electrical, plumbing, HVAC, etc.) permits, repair permits, new single-family residential construction, alteration/additions, and demolitions.
- Each permit application includes a self-reported value of the project. The **Total Value of Development (YTD)** is the sum of these reported values.

2. Development Review Board Projects

- The **Development Review Board** is a group of City staff, local utility representatives, and other local government agencies that review and comment on more complex development applications and cases that are required to go to a public hearing.
- A **Job** is a development application that requires multiple departments to review for compliance but does not require a public hearing or City Council review.
- A **Project** is a development application that requires multiple departments to review for compliance and requires a public hearing before a City Commission and in some cases, a final decision by the City Council.
- The **Staff Assigned** to each Job or Project is the primary contact person for any inquires.
