Sidewalk Work Advancing Along Adams Street At Multiple Intersections

Drivers and pedestrians should continue to use caution as OWTW Project work continues

June 12, 2024 (Peoria, IL) Sidewalk work is progressing at the intersections of Harrison Street, Liberty Street, Main Street, and Hamilton Boulevard along Adams Street. The sidewalk work at the intersection of Fulton Street and Adams Street near 124 SW Adams Street was recently completed.

Sidewalks near 332 and 300 SW Adams Street, and 100 and 200 NE Adams Streets remain closed. Sidewalk removal work at the intersection of Liberty Street and Adams Street near 200 SW Adams Street is scheduled to begin later next week. Pedestrians should continue to use caution near these closures and cross the street at the next available intersection.

Lane and parking restrictions remain in effect along SW Adams Street. On-street parking restrictions are marked. Drivers should look for unbagged, available parking meters for on-street parking. **If parking meters are bagged with “No Parking” signs, drivers should not park at those spots.**

Additional parking, lane, and sidewalk restrictions will be forthcoming as the Adams Street and Jefferson Avenue One-Way to Two-Way (OWTW) Conversion Project progresses.
