The City of Peoria is requesting Proposals from qualified vendors to assist the City in updating the American with Disabilities Act (ADA) Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan for Public Right of Way (ROW) to comply with Federal and State accessibility laws, standards, codes and regulations.

The City of Peoria's Engineering Division will accept proposals until **2:00 PM Thursday February 13, 2025** through <https://www.bidnetdirect.com/> for establishing a contract with a qualified vendor. All interested vendors are required sign up as a vendor on Bidnet Direct to submit their proposals.

The City's intention is to award a contract for these services to the best-qualified vendor. Each vendor will be considered and ranked by a Selection Committee based upon the criteria listed in the RFQ document. The evaluation criteria includes Technical Approach, Specialized Experience, Past Performance, Staff Capabilities and Workload Capacity.

**Five (5) hard copies** of the proposal should be submitted the Office of the City Engineer, 3505 N Dries Lane, Peoria, Illinois 61604 by the bidding deadline. The Request for Qualifications document and any other details of the project can be obtained at <https://www.bidnetdirect.com/>.

All firms contracting with the City of Peoria must have current certification through the City's Equal Opportunity Office. Compliance with the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act is required under this contract. The City of Peoria reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, to waive technicalities and informalities in accordance with the Statute.
