**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed proposals will be received at the Office of the City Engineer, Public Works Facility, 3505 N. Dries Lane, Peoria, Illinois, until **2:00 pm Tuesday, July 22, 2025**, for the proposed project officially known as **Green Infrastructure Maintenance - CSO Yr 1&2**. At that time, proposals will be publicly opened and read.

The proposed improvement consists of removing and replacing curb and concrete pavers, pipe drains, and filter installations at locations as directed by the City. Work may include sidewalk, curb and gutter, pavement, entrances, or other types of construction as needed. Other work may include but not be limited to traffic control, tree removal, and inlet adjustments. Site restoration shall include topsoil placement, sodding, and fertilizing, at locations as directed by the City. Necessary adjustments, incidentals and appurtenant items shall be constructed as directed by the City.

All provisions regarding EEO, prevailing wage, certified payroll, and DBE and WBE requirements shall be strictly enforced. All work shall be in compliance with specifications and all state and federal laws and regulations.

Plans, proposal forms, and specifications for the project are issued through the Offices of the City Engineer, Public Works Facility, 3505 North Dries Lane, Peoria, IL. Phone number 309-494-8800. Before plans and specifications may be obtained, contractors must be pre-qualified. Electronic documents are available by providing contact information (company name, contact name, phone number, fax number and email address) in an email request to [pwdropbox@peoriagov.org](mailto:pwdropbox@peoriagov.org). Please be specific as to which Project's plans and specifications are being requested. All proposals must be accompanied by cash, certified check, cashier's check, or a bid bond for not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond for the full amount of the contract, with sureties, to be approved by the City Engineer. **Compliance with the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act is required under this contract.** Prime Contractors have an obligation to make a good faith effort to advance the City's commitment to increase diversity among the firms working on City construction projects.

The City of Peoria reserves the right to waive technicalities and to reject any or all proposals.
